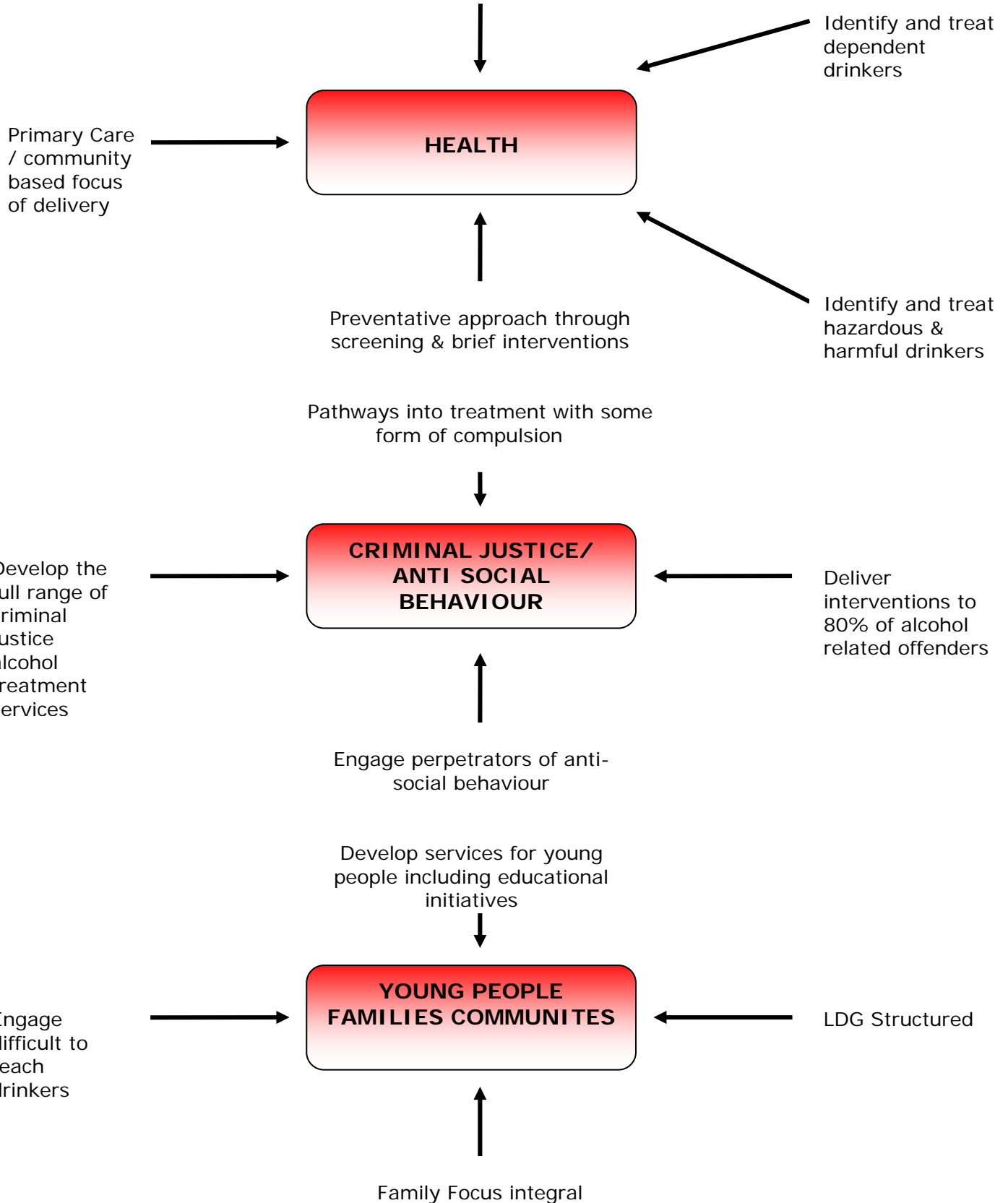

Glossary of terms:

Hazardous drinkers : a pattern of alcohol use that increases the risk of harmful consequences for the user. (binge drinking)

Harmful drinkers : a pattern of use which is already causing physical damage to health.

Dependent drinkers : characterised by physical withdrawal on cessation of alcohol or psychological dependence.
